Bynum Family Farm ~ Maysville, NC

Bynum Family Farm is located in Eastern North Carolina outside of a small town called Maysville, NC. They are centrally located between New Bern, Jacksonville and Swansboro. The Bynum Family Farm is a North Carolina Century Farm - and they were able to trace the family ties to this farm land back to the 1700s! Their families farmed tobacco, hay, corn, soybeans, and raised hogs and cows. Billy Bynum, Joshua's Grandpa, operated the last dairy farm in Onslow County until he sold his herd in 1996. After serving in the US Air Force, Joshua returned to the family farm and established Bynum Family Farm in 2020. Joshua & Kristina farm alongside with their four children (ages 12 down to 2), primarily producing pastured poultry and pork, u-pick strawberry fields, and some seasonal flowers and produce. They offer farm tours, farm-to-table dinners, and kid's activities including camps, educational days, storytimes and craft times. They're adding quite a few new things this year, including a NC Christmas Tree Lot! They are most excited about the upcoming opening of their Farm Yard (petting zoo) and a farm store called the White Oak River Mercantile, located in an old home on the farm (opening Black Friday 2023)! The store will be filled with locally raised meats, eggs and produce (from their farm as well as their farm friends too); along with loads of NC made goods from sea salt and soap, to candles, grits and more! They will serve goodies from their bakery, as well as coffee & ice cream.

White's Farm has been in business since 1986 and opens daily providing fresh fruit, veggies, and amazing flowers for the surrounding New Bern area. Produce includes strawberries, blackberries, tomotoes, cukes, squash, watermelons, cantaloupes and much more!! In the spring, White's Farm offers both PYO (pick-your-own) and pre-picked strawberries. They also grow greenhouse and field tomatoes and offer both retail and wholesale options to their local community partners. They also grow and produces all their own flowers from bedding plants to lovely hanging baskets. White's Farm also offers fall activities which include a haunted corn maze, corn pit, pumkin picking, gem mining and jump pad which is sure to provide fun for the entire family.

When she wasn't spending her days working at her mom's restaurant, Strickland Dail Dining, she could be found riding the tractor with her Dad or going with him to check the (smelly!) pigs. Strawberries on 903 is a North Carolina Certified Roadside Farm Market offering pre-picked and pick your own strawberries, fresh vegetables, cut flowers and plants, and farm fresh eggs to Greenville, NC and surrounding area residents. Located in Southern Pitt County in the heart of a thriving farm community, their property consists of approximately 250 acres. The farm is part of the Renston Community that is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. The Homestead is currently functioning as a fruit and vegetable farm, complete with a hundred-year-old tobacco barn that has been converted into a roadside stand. In the spring, visitors can pick strawberries or purchase other seasonal produce grown on the farm. During the spring and summer months, fresh vegetables, herbs, and flowers are available. Other activities include farm animal petting for the kids, pick your own strawberries, and hay rides.
